

# Jefferson-Lewis et. al. School Employees' Healthcare Plan Board of Trustees

## Election Procedures for the Employee/Retiree Trustee (E/RT) Seats

### **Section A – Eligibility of voters and candidates**

To be eligible to vote or to be a candidate for a vacant E/RT seat on the Board, a person must:

1. be a primary enrollee of the Jefferson-Lewis et. al. School Employees' Healthcare Plan (Plan);

**OR**

be an employee eligible to be a primary enrollee of the Plan that has opted for coverage under the spouse's policy, if the spouse is a primary enrollee in the Plan and the spouse qualifies under Section A(2) below.

**AND**

2. be a current member or upon retirement was a member of a bargaining unit who signed the Memorandum of Understanding between the bargaining units and their employers in the Fall of 1998;

**OR**

be a current employee or upon retirement was an employee of an employer participating in the Plan, who is or was, not in a bargaining unit.

The following bargaining units did not sign the Memorandum of Understanding:

Carthage Teachers' Association  
Indian River Education Association  
Watertown Education Association

**SPECIAL NOTE:** In accordance with the MOU of 1998, no two enrollee/retiree members may serve from the same participating district at the same time. Therefore, the current election eliminates the following districts because there are currently serving employee retiree members from those districts whose terms continue:

1. South Lewis Central School District (Michael Comet)
2. Lyme Central School District (Janice Shepard)
